TRUST HIM WITH IT. PREPARE TO WAIT AWHILE! HE IS WORKING ON IT!



#### A message from Rick Miller-Haraway



I am very excited to announce that Catholic Charities is going to have a new staff position at Catholic Parish Outreach beginning in September. As part of our strategic planning process this past year, we conducted client surveys and focus groups and asked CPO clients what other services they most needed other than food and clothing. Apart from financial assistance, the most frequent response was help getting a job. Last calendar year, 11,364 adults who were served at CPO said they were unemployed. The strategic plan, which is in the final stages of development,

recommends that CPO begin offering services such as assistance obtaining employment, nutrition education, and more. Thus, Catholic Charities applied for and received funding from United Way to hire a Case Manager/Care Coordinator to connect our clients to services at one or more of 5 agencies which are part of a collaboration aimed at helping CPO clients obtain employment. StepUp Ministry and Dress for Success will be providing job training and help connecting with potential employers. Alliance Medical Ministry will be providing medical care to the adults who lack insurance. Since care of children is essential for parents to be able to go to work, The Boys and Girls Club will be providing after-school care for school age children, and the Child Care Services Association will be consulting with our clients to help them locate childcare for their

pre-school children. The Catholic Charities Care Coordinator will be screening and assessing CPO clients to determine who will be best served by the services of these 5 agencies. The Care Coordinator will then work with the Care Coordinators of these agencies to insure that people get easy access to services and to encourage them to work to overcome the barriers to their employment. Please pray for the success of this new and exciting endeavor for Catholic Parish Outreach clients.
